### **UNDER 14, UNDER 16 & UNDER 18 EVENTS**

### **TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS**

- The Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Restricted Tournament Regulations as laid down by BADMINTON England
- 2. The U14, U16, U18 events are open to players BORN ON OR AFTER THE 1ST JANUARY in: U14 2012, U16 2010, U18 2008
- 3. All Entries to be from bona fide members of Clubs, Schools or Associations affiliated to the Wiltshire CBA and players must be eligible to play for Wiltshire in Inter-County Competitions
- 4. Players must arrive in time to play their first match at the following times:

10.15Under 16 & 18 Boys/Girls Singles13.00U18 Mixed Doubles12.00Under 16 & 18 Girls Doubles14.30Under 14 Boys/Girls Doubles12.30Under 14 Boys/Girls Singles14.45Under 16 & 18 Boys Doubles

- 5. Players may only enter events within their age group unless special exemption from the committee has been agreed prior to the entry deadline.
- 6. Players may **NOT** enter more than one age group event in the same discipline (ie U14 singles & U16 Singles)
- 7. All events will be played in group format, no consolation events will occur
- 8. The organisers reserve the right to change the format as entry levels demand.
- 9. Any competitor requiring a partner should indicate 'PARTNER REQUIRED' under partners name on the entry form (Note: there is no guarantee one will be available on the day).
- 10. Entries in doubles events are only valid if forms and fees have been received by **both** players
- 11. Feather shuttlecocks will be used
- 12. Prizes will be awarded to the winners and runners-up of each event
- 13. Players must wear acceptable badminton clothing
- 14. All players must change into indoor playing shoes when inside the venue
- 15. The draw will be seeded

# NO COACHING WILL BE PERMITTED DURING MATCHES.

In fairness to **ALL** players, there will be **NO COACHING** (including hand signals) during **ANY** of the games or **BETWEEN SETS**. Coaches and parents are asked to remain seated or if standing well away from the court to avoid inadvertently intimidating younger players. This will not preclude applause or vocal encouragement, as long it is not in the form of direct or indirect coaching.

Coaches and spectators are minded that **ALL line calls** are the sole responsibility of the players and decisions should not be influenced by anyone else off court. Please be minded not to cause unnecessary delay for players who are going on, or returning onto, court.

Coaches are welcome to come along to the competition to observe and coach their charges between matches, if they so wish, respecting the rules above.

Those that infringe the above rules, after due warnings from the tournament referee, will be asked to leave the tournament area/sports hall.

### **WILTSHIRE CBA - DATA PROTECTION**

- i) The Wiltshire County Badminton Association (WCBA) will collect certain information about you which will include your name, date of birth, Gender, BE number, e-mail address, telephone/mobile number, names of the BE affiliated clubs that you are a member of. Individual details will be held by the Association Secretary, Treasurer, Registration Secretary, County Captains and Event organisers for the sole purpose of running and organising matches and competitions on behalf of WCBA sponsored events and matters pertaining to the administration of the Association. In certain circumstances your details may be shared with Mid Wilts Badminton Association, Salisbury District Badminton Association, Swindon District Badminton Association and Badminton England for the purposes of county competitions and Administration.
- ii) Should an individual wish to 'opt out' of providing of personal information they should contact the Association Secretary. (note removal of such information will exclude the person from age related competitions and representative matches).
- iii) Information collected will not be passed or sold on to third parties.
